Everyone is invited to Franconia Sculpture Park this Saturday, as international artist Ken Payne performs an astounding iron pour: 7,000 pounds of molten iron, poured into a 7-ft-deep earthwork from his 800-lb. cupola. Sparks will fly and it will be beautifully HOT. If you have never seen a large-scale iron performance, this is your chance!

Kenneth Payne is a noted sculptor and professor known for his work in cast iron, stone, glass, and various metals. From 1990 to the present, he has taught at Buffalo State College, Buffalo, NY. He has exhibited across the U.S. and worldwide, including Finland, Hungary, Latvia, Iran, and Israel.

And don't forget our upcoming Community Collaboration Iron Pour, Saturday, August 7, from 10 AM to 6 PM.
